Members knowing the regulations particularly pertaining to dress requirements, golf course etiquette and the rules of golf can avoid many embarrassing situations. Refer to pages 6,7,9,10,11,12.

Being aware of the subjects covered in the Handbook will help all of us to increase our pleasure of playing golf at Blackwood.

PRIVACY ACT

Blackwood Golf Club Inc (BGC) is required to conform to the National Privacy Principles (NPP) as set out in the Privacy Act 1988 (a Commonwealth Act).

The NPP governs the way organisations collect, use, disclose and secure information about you. The NPP also permits you access to the information held by organisations about you in order to correct or update it.

The personal information collected and maintained by BGC for every one of our members includes your name, address, date of birth, contact details and information specific to and required for the service that we provide to members.

Information may be held on behalf of BGC by outside organisations in order to provide services to us (BGC), e.g. Australian Golf Union and Golf SA.

BGC is committed to safeguarding personal information provided by members, visitors and staff. We will never disclose any personal information unless we believe there is a threat to life, health or safety.

DRESS REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

These apply to all players and non-players including caddies and visitors, male and female (unless specified). A member inviting a guest must ensure his/her guest is made aware of these dress rules.

THE COURSE

Neat casual dress is required at all times when playing golf at Blackwood Golf Club.

Dress not acceptable on the course includes:

- 3/4 trousers (male only);
- Shirts without collars;
- Denim clothing of any type;
- Coloured socks (unless knee-high), coloured sockettes or coloured anklets (male only);
- Offensive or bold advertising, slogans or cartoons.

THE CLUBHOUSE

Dress that is acceptable for wearing on the course is also suitable for wearing in the clubhouse.

Jeans are acceptable as neat casual dress in the clubhouse provided they are not ripped or faded.

The attention of visitors to the Club, who do not play golf, is drawn to the list of dress items considered neat casual attire.

The following dress is not considered neat casual attire:

- Male – Track suits, T-shirts, tank tops and sport shorts.
- Female – Above items plus leggings, leisure/track suits, brief shorts and strapless tops.

FOOTWEAR

- Thongs and ripple-soled shoes are not permitted.
- Golf shoes may be worn in all areas on the ground floor except through the front main entrance.
- Soft spike golf shoes may be worn upstairs in designated areas only when the sprig bar is closed. Metal spikes are not permitted upstairs.
- Sandals and boat shoes are not permitted on the course, but may be worn in the clubhouse.
- Socks must be worn at all times with shoes (except when wearing sandals or boat shoes).

These standards are set for the prestige and betterment of the Club and it is essential that members and guests adhere to these standards.

Dress requirements are conveniently displayed in the clubhouse and Professional's shop.

Persons not correctly attired will be required to leave the clubhouse or course on the authority of the Professional (or person responsible for the pro shop), Manager, President or Captain of our Club.

DANGEROUS WEATHER POLICY

ELECTRICAL STORMS

At the discretion of the Manager (or Professional in the Manager's absence), the Club Competition may be postponed or cancelled in the event of electrical storms in the vicinity of the golf course.

All players must, by the sounding of the Club's weather siren, leave the course immediately, pending a further decision on whether to postpone or abandon play for the day. Players should mark the position of their ball so they can return and continue play if permitted to do so. No player will be disqualified from the competition if they leave the golf course during a round because they believe they are in danger in the event of electrical storms in the vicinity of the golf course.

ALL PLAYERS MUST LEAVE THE GOLF COURSE IMMEDIATELY AND SEEK THE SAFETY OF THE CLUBHOUSE IN THE EVENT OF ELECTRICAL STORMS IN THE VICINITY OF THE GOLF COURSE

HOT WEATHER ADVICE

The Blackwood Golf Club Committee has the health and well-being of Club members and guests as a high priority.

However, there is no current policy outlining the closure of the course or cancellation of competitions due to extreme heat.

The Committee feel each golfer is responsible for knowing their limitations and will therefore act in a responsible way to ensure their own safety. The Committee would like to ask all golfers to take caution when playing in hot weather and to please note the following tips:

- **Ensure you keep hydrated by drinking plenty of water;**
- **Wear appropriate clothing to cover yourself from UV rays – wide brimmed hat, long sleeve top, etc.;**
- **Always use an SPF 30+ sun screen (available in the change rooms);**
- **Wear sunglasses with an EPF of 10 to protect your eyes;**
- **Immediately inform your playing partners if you are having any problems.**

COURSE ETIQUETTE

No one should move, talk, and stand close to or directly behind the ball when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.

All players are required to report to the pro shop before teeing off. Players are to be at the tee 10 minutes before hitting-off time in competitions.

If unable to take your place in the field, please remove yourself from the sheet or notify the Club at least three hours before tee off. An hour's notice is not considered acceptable. Non-notification causes disruption to other members' games of golf and will not be tolerated by the Club.

The player with the lowest handicap is responsible for the observance of the Rules of Golf, Local Rules and Course Etiquette.

Players are to carry a bucket of sand to fill all divot holes including players with carry bags. In winter, divots are to be replaced and lightly sanded. At all other times, sand only should be used in divot holes.

Ball marks in greens are to be repaired before leaving to play the next hole.

Foot and club marks are to be raked out before leaving a bunker. Players should refrain from walking up the faces of bunkers, except when playing the ball.

Care should be taken not to damage the edge of the hole or the green surface when removing and replacing the flagstick or with shoe sprigs. The putter head **MUST NOT** be used to remove the ball from the hole.

When putting, leave balls in the hole until last player has putted out.

Mobile phones, except those belonging to a medical doctor or emergency services worker, must be switched off on the golf course. A mobile phone may be used in the event of a medical emergency.

CALLING UP AND GOING THROUGH PROCEDURE

When a group is looking for a ball that may be lost or has not yet been spotted, they shall immediately call the following group up (if all the group in front vacates the fairway to search the following group may assume they have been called up.) The called up group will then play their shots without delay. If the front group are still not ready to play when the called up group reaches them, the called up group shall proceed to go through. However, if the front group are ready to play before the called up group reaches them, they shall proceed without delay and the going through procedure will lapse. (NOTE: The only purpose of calling up and going through is to save time and keep the field moving. It must never be used as a penalty against the group that may be lost or a bonus for the group called up. Common sense shall prevail in the interpretation of this rule.)

Pick up the ball when strokes are exhausted in Par and Stableford competitions.

COURSE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

The Occupational Health, Safety and Welfare Act require the employer to maintain a safe working environment.

The Blackwood Golf Club has adopted safe working practices. Procedures to prevent injury to staff from golf balls are as follows: -

1. **Green Maintenance.** When the flag has been removed, the green is out of play and golfers are **not** to hit to the green until the flag is replaced.
2. **Fairway and Rough Maintenance.** Golfers **must** wait for an approaching vehicle or mower to pass behind or out of range before playing their shots. Alternatively, golfers may be called on to play their shots by the operator.
3. **Other Situations.** In all other situations, golfers **must** receive acknowledgment from course staff that are in range before playing a shot.

Failure to comply with the above procedures could result in prosecution under the Occupational Health, Safety and Welfare Act.

SLOW PLAY

YOUR POSITION IN THE FIELD IS JUST BEHIND THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU, NOT JUST IN FRONT OF THE GROUP BEHIND YOU.

With the large number of players to be accommodated on the course, it is imperative that slow play does not impede the field. The Match Committee is concerned that the affect slow play is having on the comfort of members' games.

The following time saving measures will be taken:

- Walk immediately to your ball and play if there is no danger of personal injury;
- Always play your own ball where practical before looking for any fellow competitor's ball thus minimising slow play;
- If held up in front, use this time to make club selection and practice swings;
- When reaching the green leave your bag handily placed for immediate movement to the next tee;
- Player with the honour must hit before marking card.

Players habitually offending by slow play **will** be placed at the end of the field by the Match Committee on competition days and on such other occasions as the circumstances may require.

LOCAL RULES

Local Rules and Temporary Local Rules are as printed on the Score Card and posted on the Notice Boards located under the balcony.

ORDER OF PLAY

1. All competitors in Club competitions have equal rights regardless of the number of players in the group. Groups of FOUR are the maximum number.
2. When a booking sheet is not in operation, order of play will be in the order in which groups arrive on the tee ready for play after first reporting to the pro shop.

VISITORS

1. A visitor shall be accompanied by a Member or have permission from the Manager or be part of an approved corporate day.
2. No person shall be introduced as a visitor on more than **six** occasions in any calendar year excluding competitions open to visitors.
3. A Member introducing visitors MUST sign their visitor into the green fee book with their complete name and address. The Visitor must pay the appropriate Green Fee prior to playing.
4. No visitor shall play on Saturdays without special permission from the President, Captain or Manager.
5. A Member may introduce one (1) playing visitor to the Club on Sunday (before 12:30pm) and Wednesday (before 1:30pm).
6. A Member may introduce up to three (3) playing visitors at any time on Mondays, Tuesdays (after 12:30pm), Wednesday (after 1:30pm), Thursdays, Fridays, Sundays (after 12:30pm).
7. The Member introducing a visitor is responsible for the dress and conduct of that visitor.
8. Visitors are to display the correct visitor bag tag when playing the course.
9. Hire buggies and clubs are available from the Professional.

TEE MARKERS

Men – Male golfers are to hit off blue tee markers at all times.

Women – Female golfers are to hit off the red tee markers at all times.

SCORE CARDS

As soon as practicable after the completion of a round, each player should place **his/her scorecard** in the Competition Box located in the pro shop. Twilight cards are to be placed in the box at the end of the bar.

It is the responsibility of all players to ensure that their name, date, grade and correct handicap are clearly shown on the card and that the correct score is recorded for each hole and the card is signed.

RESIGNATION

Any Member intending to resign from the Club shall signify in writing his / her intention to do so to the Manager on or before the 31st March, or shall remain liable for the subscription for the ensuing year.

MOTORISED GOLF CARTS & BIKES

(Both referred hereunder as "Carts").

Rules and restrictions for use of carts are necessary to protect areas of the course, which are liable to damage. Not only the greens, tees and bunkers, but also all unmown areas. Accordingly, to avoid damage to the course drivers of carts are asked to observe the following rules:

1. Unless on a constructed path, **carts are not to be driven within five metres of:**
 - (a) a green
 - (b) a closely mown area of a tee
 - (c) any bunker
2. Carts must be kept off all soft areas of the course where tyre marks may be left or damage done.
3. Carts are to be driven directly to the player's ball. In the event of a lost ball, the cart is to be stopped and the driver should look for the ball on foot.
4. A driver may carry one member of his group with his clubs as a passenger, upon payment of the appropriate fee, **but shall not tow the clubs of any other player.**
5. The permitted driver is responsible for all damage to Club property caused by the cart.
6. For any day with a forecast temperature in Adelaide of 40 degrees or greater carts & bikes will be prohibited.
7. The Committee reserves the right to restrict the use of carts at any time.

It is the member's responsibility if in doubt about the use of the cart to contact the Professional Shop to determine if any restriction/s apply.
8. To hire a cart, the hirer must hold a current drivers license.

Note: Etiquette prescribes that drivers of carts should not take advantage of the speed of their carts to harass groups ahead of them into letting them play through.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES AND RIGHTS

Playing rights of all categories are subject to the following general restrictions.

Men's Competition

Wednesday 10:00am – 2.30pm

Women are not permitted to play during these times.

Saturday Competition: All players in the field MUST enter the competition of the day.

Women's Competition

Tuesdays approx. 8.00am – 12.30pm

Women playing during this time MUST enter the competition of the day.

Sunday (Business Women) – time varies.

Further restrictions are listed in each category.

Membership Category Identification Disc

All members are required to display (on their golf bag) the appropriate disc obtainable from the office.

The financial year tag provided when fees are paid must also be displayed.

Full members and 7-Day Juniors Red
Provisional – A members Yellow
Provisional – B members Black
6 Day members and 6 Day Juniors Green
5 Day members and 5 Day Juniors Blue
5 Day Restricted members White
Social Playing, Sub-Junior, Try Golf members White
Country members as per base category

VOTING RIGHTS

A person who is in any one of the following membership categories, and who has a minimum of two (2) years membership of the Club, is entitled to vote and attend at every annual general meeting:

- 7-Day Member
- 6-Day Member
- 5-Day Member
- Life Member (Honorary and Purchased)
- Country Member
- Provisional – A and B Member

Full Member: A person over 18 years of age with full playing rights.

Provisional Member: A person over 18 years of age and bound by the following playing restrictions: Booking rights at the discretion of the committee.

Category - A

- Playing rights from Sunday to Friday and after 11:30am on Saturday
- May play before 11:30am on Saturday if spots are available after 3:00pm on the Friday prior.

Category – B

Sunday – Friday full playing rights. May play on Saturday after 3:00pm.

6-Day Member: A person over the age of 18 years of age subject to the following restrictions:

- No playing rights on Saturday.

5-Day Member: Weekdays only - no exceptions.

5-Day Restricted Member: Monday after 1:00pm. Thursday and Friday.

Social Playing Member:

- May play after 3:00pm on Thursday and Sunday (November 1st – March 31st);
- May play after 2:00pm on Thursday and Sunday (April 1st – October 31st);
- No voting rights apply;
- May hold an AGU handicap.

Country Member:

- Any person residing beyond 100km by road from the Adelaide General Post Office;
- Must reside for 9 months of the year at the address supplied to the office;
- A Country Member who for two consecutive months fails to fulfil the prescribed qualifications shall cease to be a Country Member;
- The address given must be a residential address not a Post Office Box, holiday house or business address;
- A 7-Day Country Member has the same rights to use the Clubhouse and course as a Full Member, provided that such use does not exceed 20 days per calendar year;
- A 6-Day Country Member has the same rights to use the Clubhouse and course as a 6-Day Member, provided that such use does not

exceed 20 days per calendar year;

- A 5-Day Country Member has the same rights to use the Clubhouse and course as a 5-Day Member, provided that such use does not exceed 20 days per calendar year;
- Voting rights as that Category of membership from which he/she transferred of joined directly as a Country Member.

Reciprocal Member: A Reciprocal Member is a member of any other Golf Club with whom reciprocal arrangements are currently in force. Transfer of membership shall be in accordance with the reciprocal arrangement with the Club concerned.

Special Member: The Committee shall have the power, notwithstanding any waiting list, to elect no more than ten Special Members in any calendar year as Members on payment of the prescribed fees, and on any conditions as may be deemed desirable by the Committee. There shall not be more than fifteen (15) Special Members at any one time. No voting rights.

Corporate Member: The Committee shall have the power, notwithstanding any waiting list, to admit Corporate Members. This membership shall be one year's duration under such conditions, as the Committee shall from time to time define. There shall not be more than ten Corporate Members at any one time. No voting rights.

Deferred Member:

- The playing rights are to be that of a visitor (play up to 6 times per year) at the member introduced fee;
- Must remain such for a minimum period of 12 months;
- Upon returning to play the Deferred Full Member will be placed at the top of the A Provisional List, the order of which will be decided by years of playing membership. A and B Provisional members will return to the same position in their relevant categories prior to deferring having not advanced on the waiting list during their absence. All other members will return to their previous categories;
- Any entrance fees previously paid (applies to members who joined prior to Feb 03) will not be forfeited upon transfer to Deferred Membership;
- No voting rights.

Medical Absentee Guidelines:

- No member in any category shall be transferred to Medical Absentee other than for health reasons;
- Upon production of a certificate from a qualified Medical Practitioner, a member shall be transferred to the Medical Absentee category for no less than twelve (12) months from the date of application. Each application will be at the General Committee's discretion;
- A Medical Absentee will pay the same subscription and have the same rights as a Deferred Member except that his/her voting rights will be maintained at the equivalent level to the Category of Membership held before transferring;
- A Member who applied for and was granted twelve (12) months Medical Absentee leave and is able to commence playing again before the twelve months has elapsed, may on the production of a medical certificate to this effect, apply to the Committee to return, under conditions set by the Committee, to his/her original Membership Category. Any period of leave less than twelve (12) months will incur a full twelve (12) months loss of Club service. Future requests to transfer to the category of Medical Absentee cannot be made for at least twelve (12) months from the date of reinstatement as a playing member;
- While listed as Medical Absentee, the Member's years of service will not continue until the Member is reinstated as a playing Member.

Social Member: A person who joins the club to use the clubhouse facilities. No voting rights.

7-Day Junior Member: A person under 21 years of age with playing rights as the Committee may from time to time determine. No voting rights.

6-Day Junior Member: A person under 21 years of age with 6 day playing rights. No voting rights.

Sub-Junior (Under 12):

Sub-Junior Members are permitted to use the course under the following conditions:

- Must always be accompanied by an adult;
- Must always give right of way to other members and visitors;
- May play on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday after 1:30pm and Sunday after 3:00pm;
- No voting rights.

Try Golf: Monday all day, Tuesday after 1:30pm, Wednesday after 2:00pm, Thursday & Friday all day, Saturday after 3:15pm and Sundays after 2:00pm. No voting rights. This category can only be done once.

**SENIOR AND VETERAN MEMBERSHIP
CATEGORIES AND RIGHTS**

Foundation Members are deemed to be those persons who joined on or before the INAUGURAL MEETING held at the Memorial Hall, Blackwood, 17/7/61.

1. **Senior Foundation Member:** 60 years of age as at 1st April 2009. Rights: That of a Full Member.
2. **Senior Foundation 6-Day Member:** 60 years of age as at 1st April 2009. Rights: That of a 6-Day Member.
3. **Senior Foundation 5-Day Member:** 60 years of age as at 1st April 2009. Rights: That of a 5-Day Member.
4. **Senior 7-Day Member:** 65 years of age as at 1st April 2009 and 25 years continuous membership. Rights: That of a Full Member.
5. **Senior 6-Day Member:** 65 years of age as at 1st April 2009 and 25 years continuous membership. Rights: That of a 6-Day Member.
6. **Senior 5-Day Member:** 65 years of age as at 1st April 2009 and 25 years continuous membership. Rights: That of a 5-Day Member.

PRACTISING

Players are to refrain from playing chip shots to any green other than the practice green at the western end of the clubhouse.

Players are not permitted to play more than one ball on any round.

CHILDREN

Children other than Junior Members are permitted in the Clubhouse, but must be under strict supervision at all times and are not permitted to play on the course, putting green or around the clubhouse.

ANIMALS

No animals are permitted on the course or in the clubhouse.

Exception - Guide and hearing dogs.

BUGGIES AND STORAGE

Application for the use of privately owned four wheel two seater motorised carts including two and three wheel ride on bikes must be made in writing to the Committee and be accompanied by a Doctor's certificate recommending the application. Permission will be given at the discretion of the Committee. No other person will be permitted to drive the cart at anytime. Approval for storage on the Club's premises when available may be given by the Committee after paying the appropriate annual fee.

Note: Any equipment stored is at owner's risk.

Golf club and buggy storage is available and administered by the Club through the office.

MEN'S HANDICAPS

"A" Grade	0 to 12

The system of handicapping in the Club is governed by Golf Australia. To ensure its proper application and to allot handicaps, which are fair to all members, whether playing in Club competitions, friendly matches or at other Clubs, it is essential that sufficient data be available to the Handicapper to enable a proper assessment to be made.

Cards must be returned from all competition rounds.

In order to obtain a first handicap a Member shall submit at least 3 completed cards. The equivalent of three 18 hole rounds must be played (ie. 54 holes). These 54 holes may consist of any combination of 9 and 18 hole rounds .

To retain an Australian Handicap a player must have not less than 3 live scores as of 1st January the previous year.

The maximum Australian Handicap is 36. Club handicaps are still permitted. Current Club maximum handicap is 36.

Increases in Handicaps: If a player's nett score is above the calculated course rating (including buffer) 0.1 will be added to all handicaps 5-32. If a player's nett score is more then 5 strokes higher than his handicap 0.2 will be added to all handicaps up to 4.4.

Buffer Categories: Handicaps 1-4, 0 Strokes; Handicaps 5-12, 1 Stroke; Handicaps 13-19, 2 Strokes; Handicaps 20 and over, 3 strokes.

Reduction in Handicaps: For each stroke a player's nett score is under the daily course rating the following will be deducted: -

Handicap 20-27.....	0.4
Handicap 28-32.....	0.5

Allotment of a GA Handicap.

- To obtain a GA Handicap a player must submit 3, 9-hole or 18-hole cards, which shall be adjusted by the Handicap Manager converting any score of more than 4 over par to exactly 4 over par. (A player may pick up when 4 over par on any hole.)
- After these adjustments are made, the 3 cards shall be averaged and the player allotted a handicap equivalent to the number of strokes by which the average exceeds the Australian Women's Course Rating (or CCR of the day).

To Retain a Handicap.

- A player must have 3 live cards at 1st January each year.
- Extra day cards of 9- or 18-holes may be submitted to retain a handicap.

The Maximum Handicap is 45.
Club handicaps are permitted.

Handicaps scratch to 3

- If a player plays above her handicap, her exact handicap increases by 0.1. If she plays below her handicap, her exact handicap is reduced by 0.1 for each stroke under her handicap.

Handicaps 4 to 45

- Buffer Zone - A buffer zone of two strokes above the AWCR (or CCR if established) for handicap 4 and over.
- If a player plays to her handicap or no more than two strokes above it her exact handicap is not changed.
- If a player plays above her playing handicap by more than two strokes her exact handicap is increased by 0.1.
- If a player plays below her playing handicap, her exact handicap is reduced by an amount per stroke determined by her Handicap Division.

SOCIAL GOLF COMPETITIONS AND HOW THEY ARE PLAYED

All social competitions are mixed events unless otherwise stipulated.

Stableford Aggregate: Two players play as partners. Each play their own Stableford round. At the end of the round the partners total their combined Stableford points.

Foursomes: Two players play as partners and use one ball. Partners hit off alternately from the tee and hit the ball alternatively during the play of each hole. Ladies use their own tees when it is their turn to play. Handicap allowance is $\frac{1}{2}$ of combined.

Canadian Foursomes: Played as Foursomes except that BOTH players play tee shots at every hole. One ball is selected and play proceeds as in Foursomes. The partner of the ball owner plays the selected ball. Handicap allowance is $\frac{1}{2}$ of combined.

Pinehurst: Both players play tee shots at each hole then play a second stroke with their partner's ball. One ball is then selected and play proceeds as in Foursomes with the owner of the ball selected playing the third stroke. Handicap allowance is $\frac{1}{2}$ of combined.

Four Ball Better Ball Par: Two players play as partners each taking strokes at holes as in a Par competition. If one of the partners wins a hole, and the other loses it, the win is counted and so on. Plus, half and minus signs are added at the end of the round and recorded as in an ordinary Par competition.

In a four ball handicap event care must be taken to mark the scores of each player in separate columns headed by the initials of the player. If the scores are mixed it is impossible for the Committee to check the card and the players may be disqualified.

Four Ball Better Ball Stableford: Played as above except that the better ball of the partnership will be credited with points instead of plus, half or minus.

Ambrose: Play consists of teams of four. Each player's drive must be used at least three times. All tee off. One ball is selected for the second shot. Players place their ball within one club length either side of the ball no nearer the hole through the green. When putting on the green the ball is placed within 1 putter length no nearer the hole. Play continues in this manner until the ball is holed out. Record initials of player's drive used on card on each hole. Handicap allowance is $\frac{1}{8}$ of combined.
