

Temporary Local Rules

Effective: Thursday 2 December 2021

New rules highlighted in red.

1 Out of Bounds or Lost Ball

When a player's ball has not been found (lost) or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds, the play may proceed under this local rule for a penalty of 2 strokes, rather than proceeding under stroke and distance. This local rule is not available if a provisional ball has been played. Please see rules cabinet and breezeway notice board for long version explanation. (MLR E-5)

2 Practice on Course (Twilight players only)

A player who has booked to play in the Twilight Competition may practice on the competition course before his or her Twilight round on that day. (**Rule 5.2** and Model Local Rule 8 I 1.2). Twilight is a compulsory competition, therefore players will not be permitted to enter more than one competition on the day nor will they be permitted to submit more than one scorecard for handicapping purposes.

Penalty for breach of local rule:

- Match play – Loss of hole
- Stroke play – Two strokes

Notes:

- Practicing on course prior to a competition is permitted for the Twilight Competition only.
- Out of Bounds and Lost Ball Local Rule will NOT be available for all club championship (including mixed and club foursomes), Pennant fixtures, or the Easter Vardon rounds event or any other declared event determined by the Match Committee.
- **Important:** When a player's ball that is embedded anywhere in the GENERAL AREA relief is allowed under **Rule 16.3a** by dropping the ball in the specified relief area (see 14.3 - the spot right behind where it was imbedded and 1 club length no nearer the hole).
